Snowshoeing 101

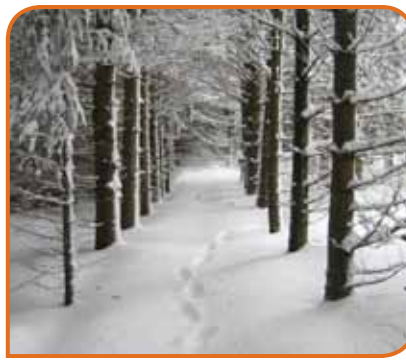
